#### Gear Manufacturer (Company Membership)

Companies that manufacture gears, gear products, and/or flexible couplings for sale as such, or as component parts of end-use products. Companies must have a bona fide gear or flexible couplings manufacturing facility. Dues are based on the total annual sales volume for the previous fiscal year. Total annual sales volume is defined as the total worldwide sales (in U.S. dollars) of all gears, gear products, and flexible couplings whether sold as such, included in end-use products or as replacement parts.

Minimum dues: \$1,994 plus \$471/\$1,000,000 of volume in excess of \$1 million

# Maximum dues: \$19,052 (for any sales volume over \$37M)

# End User (Associate Membership)

Companies that do not manufacture any gears, but use gears, gear products, and/or flexible couplings as component parts of end-use products. Dues: \$3,145
